#### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

#### **Mission**

To train competent practitioners in Business and Management well-suited for the corporate world to conduct teaching, research and community service and to promote Business policies.

#### Vision

To be an internationally recognized and reputable School of Business to produce practically oriented and dynamic manpower in Business and Management.

#### **Brief history**

The School of Business was established in September 2017 at South Campus of the University

It started as Department of Business Education under the Faculty of Social Sciences Education in 2010/2011 academic year

The department initially began with BBA programme with Accounting and Human Resource Management options In the 2015/2016 academic year, three additional options: Marketing, Procurement and Supply Chain Management, and Banking and Finance were added.

The School currently has Four Departments:

- 1. Accounting;
- 2. Management Sciences;
- Applied Finance and Policy Management;
- 4. Marketing, Procurement & Supply Chain

The School of Business, University of Education, Winneba started their Graduate Programme, Master of Business Administration (MBA) in the 2019/2020 academic year with only two specialization areas. Thus, Master of Business Administration (MBA) Accounting Option, and Master of Business Administration (MBA) Human Resource Management Option.

In the 2020/2021 academic year, all the Departments in the School of Business started a graduate programme and the number of graduate programmes increase from two (2) to four (4). Each of the Departments has one (1) Graduate Programme. The programmes are:

- Master of Business Administration-Accounting Option
- Master of Business Administration Finance Option
- Master of Business Administration Human Resource Management Option, and
- Master of Business Administration Marketing Option

The School of Business, University of Education, Winneba is the fastest-growing school of Business in terms of new programmes development and increase in the enrolment of Students annually.

The Pioneers of Master of Business Administration (MBA) Students were Thirty-Eight (38) in number, made up of Seventeen (17) Graduate Students for MBA Human Resource Management and Twenty-One (21) for MBA Accounting. Thirty-three (33) MBA Students graduated with the first batch and the remaining five (5) Students will be graduating with the second batch.

In the 2020/2021 academic year, the number increased by over one hundred (100) percent. It increased from 38 to Eighty-Two (82) Students. Below is the breakdown by programmes:

- MBA Accounting Thirty-Five (35) Students
- MBA Human Resource Management option Thirty (30) Students
- · MBA Finance Ten (10) Students
- MBA Marketing Seven (7)
   Students

In the 2021/2022 academic year, the School of Business is expecting at least Two Hundred and Fifty (250) Graduate Students because the number of graduate programmes in SoB has increased from Four (4) to Thirteen (13):

- Accounting Department: Two (2) Graduate Programmes
- Applied Finance and Policy Management: Four (4) Graduate Programmes
- Management Sciences: Three (3)
   Graduate Programmes
- Marketing, Procurement & Supply Chain Management: Four (4) Graduate Programmes

# 5.0 SCHOOL OF GRADUATE STUDIES (SGS)



The School of Graduate Studies. University of Education, Winneba started graduate programmes in the Colleges, Faculties, Schools, Institutes, and Departments for a long time. Some of the Faculties are having Doctorates Programmes like Doctor of Philosophy, Doctor of Education. The SGS has several roles to play in the Schools, Faculties, Colleges. Some of the responsibilities include the following:

- Coordinating with the schools, faculties, colleges, and Departments in the effective implementation, administration of quality assurance and enhancement of PhD, MPhil, MBA, MSc. MA, and ME'd programmes.

In August 2021, a Graduate Coordinator was appointed to help coordinate the activities of the graduate students and programmes in the School.

#### 7.0 THE GRADUATE STUDENTS

# Responsibilities of the Graduate Students

The Graduate Students are responsible for ensuring that their programme of study is consistent with the approved programme as defined in their letter of acceptance and the respective section in the Graduate Handbook. The Students are expected to read the Graduate Handbook and any other relevant documents, including notices and the University Webpage to become familiar with all regulations and

deadlines relating to their programmes. The Graduate Students have some requirements to meet as far as their programme course work, research and supervision are concerned.

#### **Program Requirements:**

The main responsibility of the Graduate students is the timely and satisfactory completion of the program requirements course work and research. It is the duty and responsibility of the Graduate Students to familiarize themselves



with their programme requirements as described in the Graduate Handbook of the school of Graduate Studies, UEW.

#### **Research Issues:**

The Graduate Student should clarify such research issues as ownership of data, authorship of publications and joint research agreements, in writing, with their supervisors and other committee members in case of a research program (PhD, MPhil etc.)

#### **Supervision:**

The Graduate Student is responsible for maintaining timely contact with supervisors and committee members (PhD. MPhil) to keep them posted on the progress of their research. The graduate student is responsible for meeting deadlines set by the Graduate School and providing quality academic research for evaluation.

### **Problematic Supervisory Relationships:**

The Graduate Student is responsible for interacting with supervisors and committee members professionally. They are responsible for maintaining positive working relationships. The Graduate Students are responsible for respecting requests for confidentiality and privacy in the research they are conducting.

# Other responsibilities of the Graduate Students include:

- · Registration as a student
- Submission of appropriate forms to the Department for signature and processing.
- Paying all fees required by Graduate School and meeting the deadline dates set out by the Graduate School.
- Students are responsible for the ethical, academic process and outcome of their research.
- They are to conduct academic pursuits ethically and develop professionally.
- Uphold the University of Education, Winneba Code of Conduct for Students.
- Defend the academic integrity for all coursework, including Regular, Sandwich. Weekend, and Distance learning courses
- Pursue all opportunities that advance a career as a Postgraduate Student and beyond.

#### 8.0 SCHOOL OF BUSINESS



The School of Business, University of Education, Winneba is located at Winneba South Campus. Formerly, the School was under the Faculty of Social Science as a Department of Business Education in the North Campus. In 2010 the first batch of the BBA Accounting and BBA Human Resource Management were admitted and graduated in 2014. The Department of Business Education was changed to the School of Business when the Departments increased from two to four. Currently, the Four (4) Departments in the School of Business are:

- Department of Accounting
- Department of Applied Finance and Policy management
- Department of Management Sciences
- Department of Marketing, Procurement and Supply Chain Management

The School admitted forty (40) graduate students for the Master of Business Administration (MBA) First Batch. Out of this number, only two (2) students did not complete their coursework. Thirty-Eight (38) students completed their course work but five still working on their dissertation. Thirty-three out of the 38 completed their coursework and dissertation and graduated with their certificate in the first session of the UEW 26th Congregation and the remaining five (5) students will be graduating with the second session of the 26th Congregation, April 2022.

With the current MBA Students, from the four Departments, we are expecting to graduate at least Eighty (80) MBA Graduate Students in the coming Year thus, 27th Congregation.

In the 2021/2022 academic year, the School of Business increase the number of their Graduate Programmes from four (4) to Thirteen (13) meaning, there will be an increase in the Postgraduate Students enrolment.

The Thirteen (13) Programmes are made up of two (2) Programmes from the Department of Accounting, four (4) from the Department of Applied Finance and Policy Management, three (3) from the Department of Management Sciences,

and four (4) from the Department of Marketing, Procurement and Supply Chain Management. The School of Business is expecting at least Two Hundred and Fifty (250) Graduate Students for the 2021/2022 academic year.

#### 9.0 DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING



The Department of Accounting presented Sixteen (16) Master of Business Administration Graduates in the first session of the 26<sup>th</sup> Congregation and the remaining five (5) graduates will be graduating with the Second Session of the Congregation.

The School of Business started the Postgraduate Programmes in the Departments of Accounting and Management Sciences because they have the majority of students. These two programmes first started under the Faculty of Social Science Education as the Department of Business Education.

Accounting Department has the highest number of Graduate Students in both the first batch and the Second Batch of MBA Students. This is because it is the oldest Programme in the school since 2010 when BBA Accounting started.

The Department of Accounting was formerly headed by Mr Samuel Gameli Gadzo and the current Head of the Department for Accounting is Mr George Kankam Jnr.

team player and a leader as well. I can fit into any state of affairs and have what it takes to face challenges and learn new things. Felicity Offei-Gyekyi is married with two kids.






