Introduction

This is in the first series of IERIS' monthly media report on education in Ghana. It provides a summary of educational issues reported in two newspapers namely; The Daily Graphic and The Ghanaian Times in January, 2023. The overall objective is to document issues on education, facilitate reference and to provide information for research in education. Our major data collection approach was to go through all the pages in the Daily Graphic and Ghanaian Times to identify issues reported on education daily. Service personnel and interns were the Research Assistants. The daily reports were collated to generate a monthly output. The report starts from 5th to 31st January, 2023. Most of the reports on education in the Daily Graphic were on page 28 while the Ghanaian Times were on pages 13, 15 and 17. The main areas covered included basic education, secondary education, tertiary education and other topics of education.

Report summary

The tertiary education report centered on accommodation for fresh students, a call for collaboration between methodist church and methodist university, digital payment platform by the Student Loan Trust for loan recovery and a breakthrough for Evangelical Presbyterian University as they rolled out postgraduate programmes.

Reports on secondary education were on support of endowment fund by Konongo Odumasi SHS, students' vandalism at Krobea Asante Technical Vocational School which led to the close down of the school, disruptive behaviours of students at Chiana, United Bank of Africa (UBA) sponsorship of the National Essay Competition for Senior High Schools and the provision of Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) facility for Mawuli Senior High School.

On basic education, there were reports on the distribution of textbooks by the Ministry of Education to basic schools, provision of infrastructure at LaDMA in the Greater Accra Region and Techiman in Bono East, and the date for the release of the Basic Education Certificate Examination (BECE). In addition, the daily graphic reported on the confirmation of Dr. Eric Nkansah as the Director General of Education and the visit of a delegation from Sierra Leone to the Ministry of Education.

Conclusion

The reports centered on tertiary, secondary and basic education. Going forward, we intend to widen the scope of search to include other media outlets such as myjoyonline and citinewsroom.com in our next series.
