1.5.14 Programme Description

The Programme aims at:

- Developing competencies and skills in the field of rehabilitation of persons with disabilities.
- The development of manpower to meet the needs of persons with disabilities.
- Deepening understanding of issues relating to rehabilitation.
- Developing the capacity to transfer knowledge and skills to persons with disabilities, family members, community groups and other service providers.

8.4.10 Entry Requirements

8.4.10.1 WASSCE Certificate Holders

- Credit passes (A1-C6) in **six subjects** comprising **three (3) Core** Subjects including English Language, Mathematics and Integrated science **OR** Social Studies; plus
- **3 (three)** elective subjects in any other area. A Credit pass in GKA and or Clothing and Textiles would be an advantage.
- TVET or any other related subject with passes not lower than C6.

8.4.10.2 SSSCE Certificate Holders

- Credit passes (A-D) in six (6) subjects comprising **three (3) Core Subjects** including English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science or Social Studies; plus
- **At least Grade D** in either Fashion or Textiles at the Senior High School Level, and
- Credit passes (A-D) in two (2) other electives in creative arts subjects such as Visual Art, Literature-in-English, General Knowledge in Arts and Clothing and Textiles
- Any other relevant related subject with passes not lower than D.

8.4.10.3 Professional Certificate/Diploma Holders:

- Candidates must possess a Higher National Diploma or its equivalent in Fashion and Textile or related subjects from recognised institutions.
- Applicants with Diploma from the Colleges of Education are also accepted. Transcripts must accompany the application forms.

8.4.10.4 ABCE/GBCE Candidates

- Full Diploma Certificate in ABCE
- Also, the applicant must have had credit passes in five (5) subjects including English Language, Mathematics, Integrated Science OR Social Studies in the GBCE or SSSCE or WASSCE.
- ABCE candidates may be considered for admission at Level 200 of a degree programme

8.4.10.5 General Certificate of Education (GCE) Advanced Level Candidates

- Passes in three (3) subjects (at least, one of the passes should be Grade D or better)
- Credit passes (Grade 6) in five (5) GCE Ordinary Level subjects including English Language, Mathematics, and

- A Science subject (for non-science students), and
- An Arts subject (for Science students)

8.4.10.6 Higher National Diploma (HND)/Diploma Candidates

- Good HND certificate (i.e. at least, 2nd Class Lower Division)
- Other Diploma qualifications equivalent to HND

8.4.10.7 Mature Candidates

- Candidates must be **at least 25 years** by **September 1** of the academic year s/he wants to enroll.
- Candidates must show proof of age with birth certificate **OR**
- Any legitimate documentary proof of date of birth which is, at least, five (5) years old at the time of application.
- Must pass the following examinations conducted by the University:
 - A General Aptitude Test and
 - A Subject Area Test
