Developed and deployed a web-based software solution to optimize the management of the University's Documenter—a publication encompassing official announcements, notices, and pertinent information for the academic community. This innovative solution effectively addresses the repetitive nature of this task, resulting in a marked improvement in operational efficiency and overall productivity.

Designed and deployed an Online Photo Album system aimed at serving as a repository for preserving UEW's institutional image through visual storytelling. This system empowers Schools and Faculties to showcase their academic activities through curated photo galleries. Additionally, it boasts features that facilitate easy access to images for graphic and web design endeavors.

Established a web-based mechanism designed to facilitate the seamless submission of research and publications by faculty and staff for inclusion in the university's publications. This solution simplifies the submission process for faculty and staff, while also expediting collation for departmental officers in charge.

Implemented a web application to extract pertinent information such as names, programs, and class honors from spreadsheets containing the list of graduating students. This data is subsequently formatted into a non-tabular listing for publication in the list of graduands every

congregation. This process significantly optimizes workflow, as manual extraction would entail a substantial time investment.
