GENERAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

PH.D. PROGRAMMES (REGULAR/FULL TIME MODE)

Applicant should possess a Researched Master's Degree in the relevant field of study from with at least grade "B" in the thesis/dissertation.

ONE YEAR TOP-UP TO M.PHIL PROGRAMMES (REGULAR/FULL TIME)

Candidate must possess a good Master of Education/Master of Arts/Master of Science in the relevant field of study.

TWO-YEAR M.PHIL. (FULL-TIME) & MBA (WEEKEND) PROGRAMMES

Candidate must possess a good first degree in the Candidate must possess a good first degree in the relevant field of study. Applicants who are qualified members of the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC) may apply.

MASTER OF EDUCATION PROGRAMMES (SANDWICH AND DISTANCE)

- Applicants should possess a good Bachelor's, with education component, in the relevant field of study from any recognised University.
- Applicants with B.A. or B.Sc. degree without education component must have a Postgraduate Diploma in Education or Diploma in Education in addition.

M.SC./M.A. AND PGDE PROGRAMMES (SANDWICH AND WEEKEND)

Candidate must possess a good first degree in the relevant field of study.

POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN TEACHING & LEARNING IN HIGHER EDUCATION (WEEKEND)

To qualify for this programme, the applicant should be a:

- Beginning lecturer in the University of Education, Winneba or any other recognized tertiary institution who has no formal qualifications in teaching in Higher Education. Or
- Master's/Doctorate degree holder who wishes to pursue academic career as a teacher in tertiary institutions. Applicants with Master's degree must, in addition, possess at least 2nd Class Lower Division in the first degree from any institution accredited by the Ghana Tertiary Education Commission.

- Candidates who are applying for a research degree programme must attach a detail proposal of intended research.
- The duration of M.Ed., M.A. and M.Sc. programmes that are run on sandwich mode is one (1) sandwich year, that is, two (2) sessions, within which students are expected to complete the writing of their dissertation. Fees for sandwich programmes are paid per session.
- Fees for regular and distance programmes are paid per each academic year.
- Distance and Parttime programmes are run on weekends while regular and full-time programmes are run on week days.
